

## **Submitting Artwork to FBCA Exhibits**

You may bring several pieces of your artwork to the gallery on "Receiving Day," which is always the Sunday (11-5pm) before the First Friday of each month. Over 200 pieces of artwork are submitted to each exhibit. The selection of artwork is based solely on what combination of submitted artwork creates the best exhibit. There is no guarantee the submitted artwork will be exhibited and entry fees are not refundable. 10-30% of submitted artwork is not included in the exhibit. Artwork not included in the exhibit must be retrieved before the Opening Gala.

## **Key Points - Submission/Exhibiting Policies**

Artwork should not have been exhibited anywhere in Alameda in the previous 12 months.

Artwork must be for sale.

Artwork must be "ready to hang/display with secure eye hooks in the top of the frame. We can't hang from centered (saw-tooth) or unstable eye hooks.

Artwork must be presented in "like-new" professional quality.

Artwork must be labeled with artist name, title, medium.

Jewelry must have a price tag attached to each piece.

Unframed canvas edges must be painted or artistically finished with no staples showing.

Artists are required to pay a storage fee of \$5 per day and per piece for any artwork left at FBCA after deadlines.

FBCA does not take any responsibility for artwork that is damaged while on display or stored at the art center.
