Prospectus

Once again, the Frank Bette Center for the Arts will turn its galleries into a wonderland of art created by our talented artisans. We will be featuring jewelry, paper fiber arts, prints, ceramics/mosaics, wood, glass and framed two-dimensional art works 12'x12" or smaller.

Holidays at Frank Bette: Friday December 1 -Sunday December 3, 2023, 11am-5pm.
Application deadline: Sunday November 12.
Selection notification by: Friday November 17.
Intake day: Sunday November 26, 11am-5pm
Reception: Saturday December 2, 3-5pm
Pickup day: December 3 after 5pm, or by agreement of the gallery.

- Each artist will be allocated a 3ft x 3ft space to display art.
- Artists may show one type of artwork or different types. For example, if you submit images of scarves, you may show only scarves. If you submit images of scarves, and jewelry, you may both types of art within the allotted space.
- Submit images via email of at least two (2) samples of the work you intend to sell to Holidays@frankbettecenter.orgno later than November 12, 2023.
- All images should be labeled with: the artisan's name and price range of the items and description of materials used.
- You will be notified no later than **Friday November 17** if your art has been accepted. Note that space is at a premium so limits may be placed on the total number of similar items.
- Accepted work will be received into the gallery **Sunday**, **November 26 from 11am-5pm**. Please bring displays or display boxes for your art and be sure to label them with your name. A table-top holiday tree will be available to hang holiday ornaments.
- Please also bring completed inventory sheet and signed consignment agreement.
- If you are accepted, we may want to use one of your submitted images on marketing materials (show postcard & poster, email blast, website).
- A non-refundable entry fee is \$10 for members or \$12 for nonmembers. Consider joining the Frank Bette community (\$65 annually) to receive the reduced fee.
- Artist commissions are 70% with the gallery receiving 30% so price your art accordingly.

The FBCA reserves the right to turn down any work that it deems unacceptable or varies significantly from the images submitted.

All work must be hand crafted by the Artist. No kits, copies or commercially produced work will be considered.
