

## Materials List for Elaine Carpenter Workshop For Oil Painting I & II

- ✓ Small sketch book/pad
  - ✓ Pencil #B 2 thru 4
  - ✓ Eraser, soft kneaded such as “Design” brand
  - ✓ Paint pallet for oils, **Preferred style is 12” x 16”, plastic, box-like with a cover and “wax” coated paper which fits inside.**
  - ✓ Paint knife, such as Blick's steel, style #2 with 2" blade (rounded head or sharper pointed head)
  - ✓ Paint brushes for oils (recommend Robert Simmons "Signet" brand):
    - #6 Bright
    - #3 or 4 Flat
    - #1 Round
    - Brush Cleaner: “The Master’s” Brush Cleaner and Preserver small 2.5 oz. container. Better: a small plastic bottle of “Pink” soap.
    - Weber Turpenoid oderless 6 oz. size, and small bottle of Linseed oil for oil paint medium
  - ✓ Oil paints (small size 37ml tubes):
    - French Ultramarine
    - Cadmium Yellow Light or medium
    - Alizarin Crimson
    - Titanium White
    - Payne’s Gray
- \*Brands which are preferred - Windsor Newton (for artists) and Gamblin.
- ✓ 2 – 3 small, readymade canvases: 9x12 . E.g. Blick's professional line of canvases.
  - ✓ Optional to stretched canvases: Canvas Boards
  - ✓ Jars with lids:
    - One small size (4 – 6 oz...)
    - One larger (12 – 13 oz.) Anything like jam jars with wide mouths will do.
  - ✓ Paper towels, Viva is preferred.
  - ✓ Latex gloves, fitted, medical type ( 2)
  - ✓ Where to get these items:
    - Blick Art Stores (Berkeley or Oakland)
    - Artist and Craftsman, Berkeley may not have everything you need, but, often, has some good sale items
