

Exploring Monochromatic Painting Workshop Materials List

- Medium to large watercolor brush
- Watercolor paper or watercolor sketchbook, hot press for smoother paper
- Large water container (if it's bigger you won't have to change it so often)
- Any monochromatic watercolor such as burnt sienna or umber or any dark color. Browns are preferred; reds and pinks don't work as well. Blues are OK. But use what you have and we will figure it out!
- ArtGraf water-soluble graphite is one of my favorite things to paint with. You can find it here on [Amazon](#).
